- Monday: Complete the Daily Math Practice worksheet Week 1 & Week 2
Journal Writing Topic Science - What do you do if a tornado develops.
(Remember what we practiced at school.) Draw me a picture.
Spend some time in IREADY, IXL, or Prodigy Math.
- Tuesday Complete the 'tens and ones' worksheet.
Journal Writing Topic Social Studies - Draw a picture of Arkansas and
identify where Weiner is on that map.
Spend some time on IREADY, IXL or Prodigy Math
- Wednesday Complete the worksheet titled 'Interpret Graphs'. Don't forget about the
subtraction problems at the bottom!
Journal Writing Topic - Lists the months of the year - in order. Circle your
favorite month.

- Thursday Complete the Tens sheet (behind the graph sheet). Be careful with the
problems below - they're trying to trick you.

- Friday Draw a large circle. Place the numbers inside so it becomes a clock.
Now place the hands showing the time of 3:30. Remember the little hand is the
hour and the longer hand is the minutes.

EXTRA ACTIVITIES --

1. Practice writing your numbers from 1 to 200. Make sure the numbers are in the right directions.
2. Draw the shapes we have studied: circle, square, triangle, cone, octagon, rectangle, cube, rectangle prism, hexagon, cylinder, rhombus, sphere
3. Draw a pizza. Divide into equal parts. Practice on the fractional part you may eat. $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{8}$.
